The Sociology Society visited the Korydallos prison on **Friday, 30th of November, 2012.** Sociology Society Advisor Ms. Lagoumitzi and seven Sociology students were received by the prison sociologists, Dr. William Aloskofis and Dr. Konstantinidou, who provided an extensive two-hour briefing about the prison conditions, the population profile and special programs and initiatives that the system offers. Dr. Aloskofis introduced the students into the role of the sociologist in the prison environment. Professor Zouganelis, head of the Prison School, joined the discussion during which he explained to the students the challenges of the Prison School which is part of a wider program of providing inmates with a second chance. Dr. Aloskofis distributed his latest statistical analysis of the prison population to all Deree visitors. The discussion that followed was very lively and is certain to stimulate further the students' interest in the Sociology of Deviance and Criminology in the future.
